The "CANOL" (Canadian Oil) trail is the remnants of a war time engineering marvel, with the original intention of piping oil from the Norman Wells field out to Whitehorse in the Yukon. The road and pipeline were built between 1942 and 1944, and were shut down after one year of operation. Over 20,000 workers completed this project and when in full operation carried over 3,000 barrels of oil per day
